Change to A2 issued in addendum #2

Q&<u>A:</u>

- Q1. Can please confirm that we are responsible for the back boxes at the teacher and display locations?
- A1. [DA-MJD] Backboxes specified within the IT drawings are required by the bidding contractor of this project.
- Q2. In the wiring diagram on IT-301 they show a RS-232 wiring connection from the Vivitek IFP Display and the Frontrow ICR-01 in the enclosure. What type of control is this wiring supposed to perform?
- **A2. [DA-MJD]** Control panel shall control the display on/off, display input selection, and program volume-up/down. Classrooms do not require control panels. RS-232 cable from display to ICR-01 is not required.
- Q3. I had a question regarding the Frontrow Part # 1000-00153 Ceiling Option, Integrated 950CS Ceiling Sensor Kit item #'s 7 and 8 on the equipment list attached to this e-mail. The part number is listed twice for a QTY of 57. Is this correct? I just wanted to make sure it wasn't an error of a part # being duplicated?
- **A3.** [DA-MJD] each interactive display shall receive qty (1) ceiling sensor kit for IR wireless microphones.
- Q4. Do the CAT6/CAT6A patch cables in the BoM take into account the endpoint (WAP or Phone) side of the connection? If not, shall we provide these?
- **A4. [DA-MJD]** Wireless AP's and connections at the device ends are by the owner. Do not include patch cords at the Device end.
- Q5. I see in one section of the RFP (27 2129-1, Section E7) that UPS's and PDU's shall be procured and delivered by others. I also see a BoM provided in section 27 2129-10 for UPS's and PDU's. Could you clarify if the winning bidder needs to provide this equipment?
- **A5. [DA-MJD]** TE-01 @ TE-02, Section 27 2129 are not to be publicly bid as part of this request.
- Q6. Will all installed switches and WAP's be using the same or similar configs as the equipment in the building currently?
- **A6.** [DA-MJD] TE-01 @ TE-02, Section 27 2129 are not to be publicly bid as part of this request.
- Q7. Just a note that the RFP states all stacking will be done with Cisco StackWise, I just wanted to clarify that this will actually be Meraki 40G Stacking cables, not StackWise.
- A7. [DA-MJD] TE-01 @ TE-02, Section 27 2129 are not to be publicly bid as part of this request.
